**Per Court :-**

1. We had directed the learned DSGI vide paragraph 7 of our order dated 10.10.2022 to tender the list of those students along with their account numbers, who have received scholarship amounts through direct deposits in their accounts.

2. We are aware that such direct deposition of amounts to the tune of Rs.63 crores and odd in favour of two lacs and odd students, is in direct conflict with our order and direction dated 23.03.2022. When we directed that the amounts would not be credited to the accounts of the students considering the controversy before us, the Union of India has distributed Rs.63 crores within seven days after the order of this Court. The Union of India had approached the Honourable Supreme Court against

the orders of this Court and we are informed that the SLP has been dismissed by the order 23.09.2022.

3. In view of the above, we are directing the learned DSGI to place the list of students, in whose accounts the scholarship amounts were deposited directly on or before 30.03.2022. The list of officers, who sanctioned such payments, would also be placed before us.

4. Stand over to 22.11.2022 (tomorrow) in the passing orders category.
